The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) provides training and education through the National Highway Institute (NHI). FHWA and NHI have developed the web-based training option of the 4-hour TIM Responder Training. **The web-based option covers the same 33 learning objectives in ten self-directed modules allowing you to train on YOUR time at YOUR schedule.** Once an individual completes all ten modules, you may print your course completion National TIM Training Certificate that is equivalent to completing the in-person 4 hour version of the National TIM Responder Training course

The NHI web-based training class was updated in 2017 and includes new case studies, statistics and videos.

To take the NHI web-based TIM Responder training:

1. **Register** for a NHI account, click on "Login": <https://www.nhi.fhwa.dot.gov/>*
2. Search for course FHWA-NHI-133126A and add it to your cart*
3. Complete all **ten modules**
4. Pass the final exam
5. Complete the course evaluation
6. Print/download your course completion **National TIM Certificate**

The estimated total time to complete all 10 modules is approximately 4 hours.

National TIM Training Certificate

Through a special agreement with the Federal Highway Administration, the Responder Safety Learning Network (RSLN) offers a National TIM Training Certificate for registered users who complete ten specific RSLN online self-paced programs.

To earn credit for each program, you must view the program in its entirety and pass the Skills Challenge test. Once you earn credit for all ten programs, you will be able to download a special certificate that is the equivalent of completing the National Traffic Incident Management Responder Training Program.

When you have completed all the programs, go to the User Console and click National TIM Training Certificate to download your certificate. You can also access the certificate from your Completed Programs page and from each required program's details page. Once you have earned the certificate, it will be listed in your transcript. If you have any technical problems, please file a support ticket.

Responders have a second online option for completing the National TIM Responder Training course. The Federal Highway Administration worked closely with the Emergency Responder Safety Institute to review the training modules they have available through the Responder Safety Learning Network (RSLN). It was determined that if individuals complete the following ten RSLN modules they will have covered all 33 lesson objectives of the National TIM Responder Training course:

1. Advance Warning
2. Blocking Procedures at Roadway Incidents
3. High Visibility Innovations
4. Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD)
5. Move It or Work It
6. See and Be Seen: Emergency Lighting Awareness
7. Special Circumstances: Safe Operations for Vehicle Fires
8. Special Hazards
9. Termination
10. TIM: Incident Command & Management

Once an individual completes all ten modules, they can download a National TIM Certificate. It is important to note that past completions count towards the certificate, so if you are a RSLN user you may only need to take one or two more modules to receive your certificate.

To obtain your National TIM Training certificate:

1. **Register** for an RSLN account: learning.respondersafety.com*
2. Click on "[TIM Certificate](#)"*
3. Complete and pass the Skills Challenges for all **ten modules**
4. Obtain an RSLN certificate for each module
5. Obtain a **National TIM Certificate** for successful completion of all ten modules

The estimated total time to complete all 10 modules is approximately 4 hours.
